WOODSTOCK INN & RESORT.....

The Woodstock Inn & Resort is located in the center of Vermont in the village of Woodstock. Known as the prettiest small town in America, the village is like no other town in New England. Step outside The Inn and you will find locally owned specialty boutiques, shops, art galleries, coffee shops and restaurants. The spectacular scenery of Woodstock's historic architecture, rolling hills, local farms, and covered bridges add to the town's charm. The Inn has recently renovated its 142 guest rooms, including new bathrooms, furniture, flat screen televisions, and carpeting. Guests enjoy complimentary coffee and afternoon tea, and unlimited Internet access. There is a Health & Fitness Center and two swimming pools.

WADSWORTH ATHENEUM MUSEUM OF ART.....

The Wadsworth Atheneum is one of the nation’s oldest continuously operating public art museums with more than 40,000 works of art, spanning 5,000 years; 15th to 20th century paintings, American furniture, sculpture, porcelains, and English and American silver.

MARSH-BILLINGS-ROCKEFELLER MANSION.....

The Marsh-Billings-Rockefeller Mansion is an excellent example of the Queen Anne style. The Tiffany Glass Company of New York designed several stained glass windows and provided the wallpapers and fabrics for the mansion. The Mansion contains an extensive collection of American landscape paintings.

BILLINGS FARM & MUSEUM.....

The Billings Farm and Museum exhibits include an operating dairy farm and an 1890’s farmhouse. We’ll enjoy a wagon ride on the farm with vistas of the 550 acre Mount Tom Forest.

SIMON PEARCE.....

The Simon Pearce pottery and glassblowing complex has become an emblem of Vermont. We’ll enjoy lunch at the spacious contemporary restaurant with beautiful forested views of the Ottauquechee River. Lunch is on your own.

QUECHEE GORGE.....

Often referred to as Vermont’s “Little Grand Canyon,” the Ottauquechee River has carved out a mile-long chasm that offers dramatic views of the landscape and neighboring towns.

SAINT-GAUDENS NATIONAL HISTORIC SITE.....

We’ll visit the former residence and studio of sculptor Augustus Saint-Gaudens built circa 1800. Saint-Gaudens famous works The Puritan, Adams Memorial and Shaw Memorial are among the 100 works on display.

THE MARK TWAIN HOUSE & MUSEUM.....

Tom Sawyer, *Huckleberry Finn*, and other books were published while Samuel Clemens (Mark Twain) lived in this three-story Victorian mansion featuring decorative work of Charles Confort Tiffany; Tiffany-glass light fixtures, windows, and Tiffany-designed stencilwork in gold and silver leaf.
